October 2020 – Industry Appreciation Month – Please submit articles that feature local industry and what they provide the Frankfort/Franklin County community and the world; industry leaders in our community; industry employees that stand out; the variety of family-sustaining careers that are available within local industry; numbers employed; wages and tax revenue provided to the community; global outreach; the diversity our industry bring to Frankfort,... We will feature a daily Industry Fun Fact during this month.

November 2020 – **Downtown Businesses, November to Remember Events** – Please submit articles about events planned for the holidays, what special things downtown businesses provide the community, what downtown developers and developments bring to the community; your future plans for downtown development, articles about business owners downtown...

December 2020—Commercial and Residential Real Estate Development - Article topics might include the predicted shift of population growth to rural communities and how the lack of housing in Franklin County will keep us from benefiting from that shift; what the lack of housing costs our community; the predicted restructuring of industry and how the lack of available property will negatively affect our community; the many construction jobs generated within a community during local development projects; the amount of empty commercial space in Frankfort; any development that you (or someone)

are doing; barriers to development; comparison of ours vs neighboring communities new housing over the past 20 years; the housing markets link to consumer spending...

January 2021 – Technology Industry. Please submit articles that feature local technology companies and what they provide the Frankfort/Franklin County community and the world; tech leaders in our community; technology employees that stand out; I would love to have submissions from local teachers discussing the constant changes in technology and how they address that in the classroom; increased demand in technology due to pandemic; stories about anyone who has taken a recent technology class and gotten a job; the career path of a local IT professional...why/when you made the decision to do what you do; Artificial Intelligence and how it will affect our community/world...

February 2021 – Minority and Veteran Owned Businesses. This month will feature speakers and articles about/from black businesses and black business owners, Hispanic businesses and owners; veterans and their businesses; stories of our minority community's history of entrepreneurship; any programs KSU has to promote minority entrepreneurship; special loans or other funding to promote minority owned businesses; SBDC loans for minority business development; importance of immigration to businesses and the local economy...

March 2021 – Small Business Month – We will feature information about small businesses and small business owners; special funding opportunities for small businesses, information around the celebration of Small Business Development Day...

April 2021 – **Women and Family Owned Businesses** – We will feature information about/from women or family business owners and their businesses in our community; business women in our community; EmpowHER; resources, special funds/grants/loans for women owned businesses...

May 2021 – Tourism Related Businesses and Events. This month we will focus on the beginning of summer tourist season, who is open and when, what are the guidelines for visiting, etc...; special employees within our tourism businesses; what <u>events</u> are taking place over the summer and guidelines...

June 2021 – **Environmental/Agricultural Businesses** – This month should focus not only ag-related businesses or businesses people, but on businesses within the community that are environmentally friendly and practice sustainability.

July 2021 – This is National Culinary Arts Month so we will feature articles on local **food, drink and entertainment establishments**, their owners and workers...or even their patrons. These can include caterers and food trucks...

August 2021 – In honor of **National Inventors Month** we will feature articles from/about local entrepreneurs and their businesses; any KSU entrepreneurship programs; SBDC entrepreneurship programs, governors School for Entrepreneurs experiences; KY National Federation of Independent Businesses articles...

September 2021 – **Bourbon-related Businesses** – September is National Bourbon month, so we will feature information about bourbon-related businesses and business owners; information about the celebrations and events planned for that month...
